



### KITCHEN AND BREAKFAST NOOK (above and bottom left)

In the kitchen, the homeowners sought a space that would include guests but keep them out of the work area. They turned to Ulrich in Ridgewood to create a streamlined design featuring a curved dining counter accented by tiny glass tiles and counter stools of burgundy patent leather. The hammered nickel dining table has a honeyed oak surface typical of the period, accented by satin leather chairs. Similarly, a '60s-inspired chandelier features a classic mica shade beneath a hand-forged metal cage. Sheers and Roman shades of woven metal in shades of burgundy and gold pick up the colors of the kitchen's striking glass backsplash, a natural complement to the room's numerous pieces of collectible glass art. >
